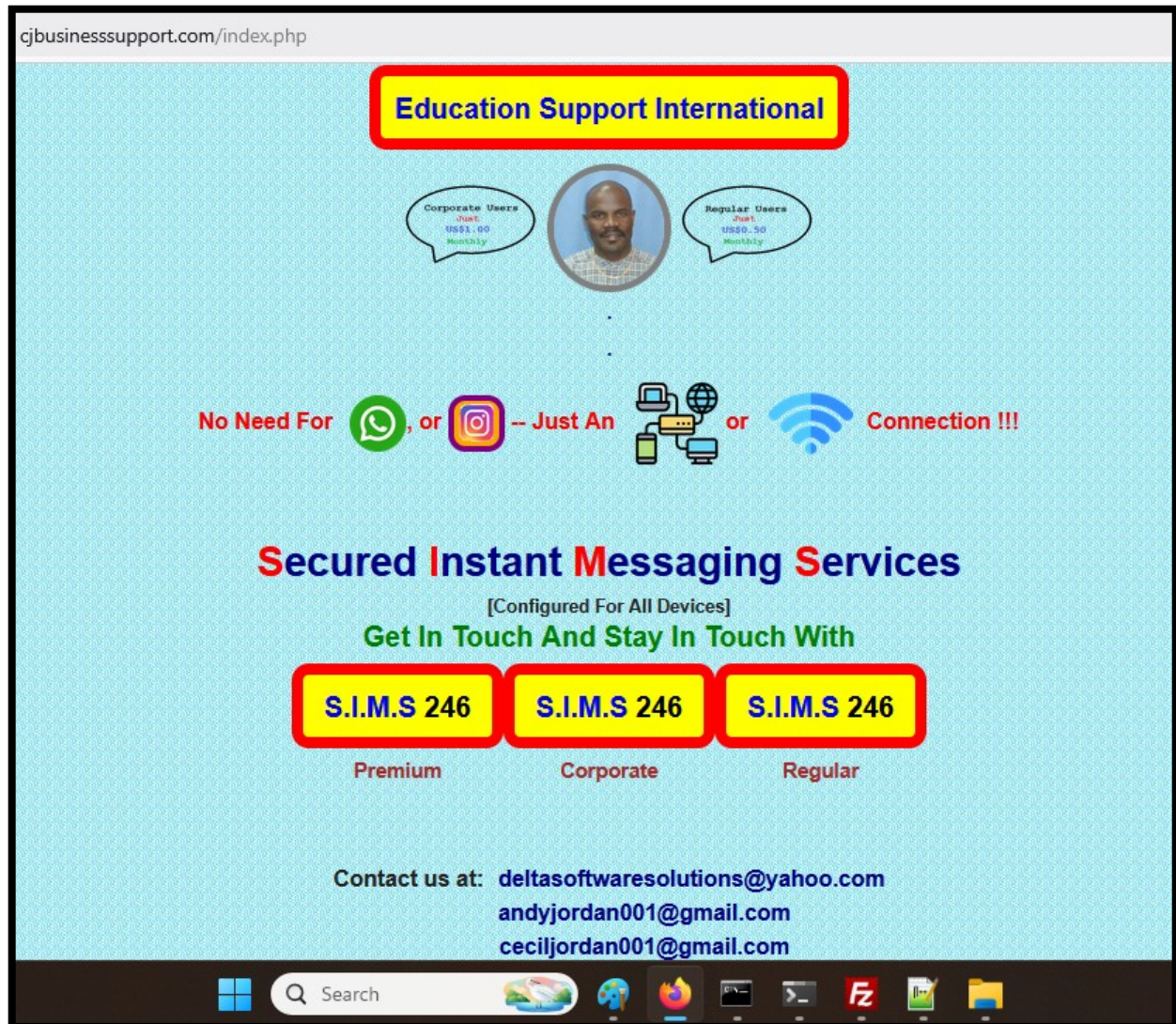
Details on the S.I.M.S 246 project for Morning Barbados

My name is Cecil Anderson Jordan, of Lot 21, 2nd Avenue, Battaleys, St.Peter.

I am associated with the business Delta Software Solutions, which is registered in Barbados.

I am hoping to introduce the above-mentioned project to the wider public both domestic and external for their consideration.





The above images represent segments of the home page of the S.I.M.S 246 project.

This project is called Secured Instant Messaging Services or (SIMS246) (one word) as the catch phrase.

I am aware that there are messaging services programs in the global space, but I can assure you that this is not a copy-cat of any existing system.

As a computer programmer, I had developed a gaming program that I wanted to place on the internet, and I wanted to have a facility where two persons can play each other simultaneously and respond in real time remotely.

Being aware that no two computers/devices can share the same memory space even though there are connected to the same application on line, I had to find a solution.

My expertise in computer programming over the years, even before the advent of the internet was in the area of Database Management and Programming.

Therefore, I concluded that on the internet, they cannot share the same memory space, but they can share the same common data source.

That was my 'light-bulb' moment, and as they say 'The Rest is History'.

Having tested the algorithm and achieved positive results, I wanted to extend this concept to a project that would have a greater appeal and utility.

And that is where the inspiration came for me to create some kind of textual communication process where users could get the opportunity to connect with friends, family or indeed business associates all over the world.

With the pervasive video and streaming facilities currently in existence, I felt that a system like this, could bring us back to an environment that we once cherished and appreciated, whilst at the same time still remaining relevant as a viable connectivity mechanism in this modern era.

I still have plans of launching the gaming program, but I have decided to place this one as priority because of the potential that it has to make a positive impact world-wide and could very well be a foreign exchange earner for Barbados.

Project Description

I have segmented the project into three main divisions and they are -:

Premium

Corporate

Regular

The Premium category is configured to deal with messaging procedures at the highest level that could be at the government to government level across countries.

The Corporate category can relate to government entities or business entities both public and private.

The Regular category would relate to the level of citizens, friends, families, social groups etc.

Each category will accommodate an innumerable amount of persons, who by just being members of the platform can engage in chat, discussions or any form of textual exchange on line 24 hours a day, seven days a week basis.

There is no time limit.

The intended users will have to sign-up on the platform and will have the option of choosing any already pre-programmed usernames and submitting their own individual passwords.

The usernames will be a combination of the prefix of the particular group followed by the phrase/word 'Persons' and the number representing that user name in the option order.

This means that a user cannot be readily identified, and this forms a greater degree of privacy and security.

However, if a user wishes to be known on the platform, because of his/her social standing, they can have the option of full exposure as their preferred default user settings.

The fee for membership is set as \$US1.00 per month per user for the Corporate Level service and \$US0.50 per month, per user for the Regular Level.

No fee is set as yet for the Premium membership. This can be discussed and negotiated at a higher level due to the significance of this classification.

Once the user has registered and settled all financial obligations, they can begin to correspond immediately.

This system does not require the user to have any active telephone service or any specialized system or exceptional user verification.

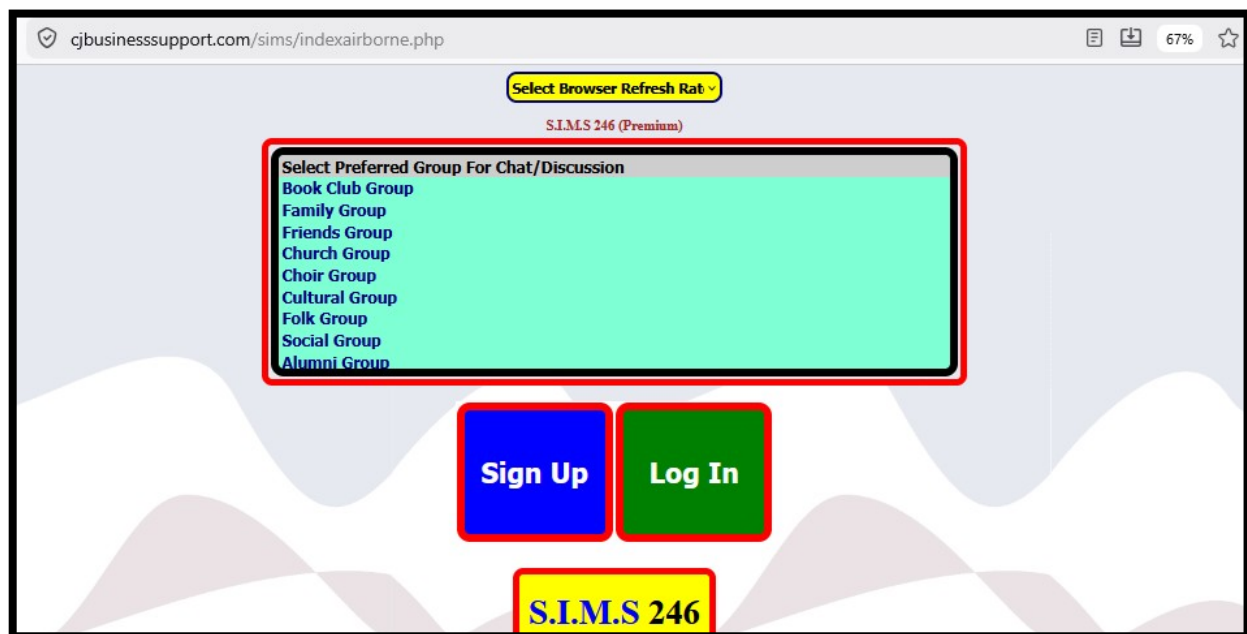
All that is required by the users is any device, whether it is a mobile phone, tablet, laptop or desktop computer and an active internet connection, whether by Ethernet or WIFI.

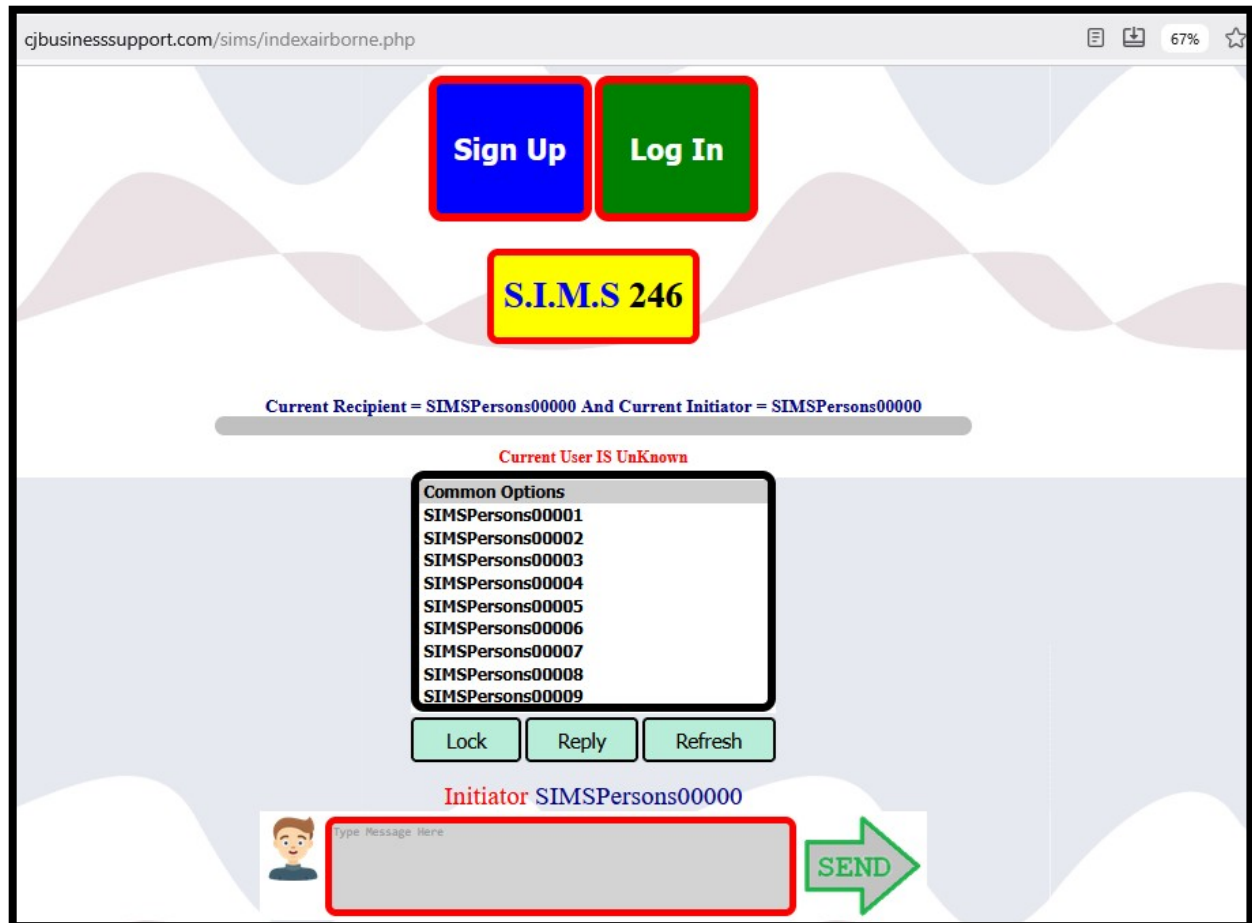
The program has also been configured to actively engage in data-encryption from end to end to maintain a high level of data security and user confidentiality.

I will also add that all the functionality that this program offers is provided by this computer programmer and there is not any third-party plug-ins or other associated functionality authored by any other source.

Please find below images of the various activities that this program will offer. I will leave any other discussion on the same for a future engagement that we may have on this matter.





The above images show the top portion of the screen when the user selects the Premium mode as the category for their messaging service.

The first button (Select Browser Option) permits the user to set the refresh rate that he/she wishes to implement. Or even no refresh rate at all.

The purpose of this refresh rate setting in the program, allows the browser to refresh automatically so that the user can see the responses made by the contacts immediately upon being made without the user having to intervene to refresh.

The line immediately below describes the category in active engagement.

The [Preferred Group for Discussion] option box, allows the user to select the group to which he/she wishes to engage.

Upon selecting this group, the [Common Options] box below will be populated with all the members of the selected group. As a result, the user will have the

option of choosing any member of this options list for active communication and engagement.

By default, where there is no activity, the message box and the [SEND] command are disabled or deactivated.

However, once the user has been declared and has chosen a recipient, all required boxes and buttons are activated to support the required activity.

The below images show the result of an engagement and the corresponding activities both from the caller and the receiver's perspective.

This pattern is similar and consistent across the other two categories, so there is no need for any other separate graphics.

But, just be aware that the options listed for use will be tied to the category chosen by the user.

The above image clearly represents the result of a connection made between the Initiator and a Recipient with the level of exchange shown. This would be the display when users are connected and engaging.

The immediacy of the conversation clearly demonstrates the effectiveness of such a system, especially when urgent information is required to deal with a prevailing circumstance.

This could very well represent an emergency situation where one of the parties is off-site and the only credible available resource is this portal, which is configured with a multi-layered information pool, where access to personnel of all spheres is readily available and accessible.

Why these two sites?

The reason I have the two sites hosting the same program is because when I was testing the remote access theory for the games and ultimately the SIMS246 program, I had to create the condition where I could play the role of sender and receiver on the same computer system.

This was the only alternative that I had during the development process. One site will be used solely for the caller and the other one for the recipient.

In this way I was able to play both roles and observe the interaction and accessibility from both sides.

The exercise has gone so well that I intend to allow the programs to live on both sites.

This will create a great advantage in that, in the event that I have to do some files or database management, I could shut down either of the two systems for the duration required, with (0%) loss to the users.

Furthermore, this situation would also be advantageous to the user experience, in that if they have a choice of going on either site for their activity, this could reap rewards in the area of load balancing and reduce/eliminate any issues relating to latency.
